

PANDEMIC PROTOCOL – 4 PILLARS OF SAFETY

SCREENING

Before leaving the house, a parent needs to take the student's temperature and scan for illness symptoms.

PEG staff will take their temperature before reporting to work.

Staff and students should not enter PEG if they are presenting any questionable signs for illness or if they have been travelling within 14 days of attendance. Please see the CDC Guidelines

HYGIENE

All students and employees will wash their hands upon arrival. *Parents need to properly teach their children how to wash their hands.*

Students will sanitize their hands after events with high touch surfaces

Employees will wash their hands between each class.

Bring a water bottle already filled. *Drinking fountains will remain accessible as a refill station only.*

Our restrooms will remain accessible with limited capacity. *Please have your child use the restroom before leaving the house.*

Please teach your child to sneeze or cough into their elbow or shirt. *If a child sneezes or coughs into their arm, they will be sent to wash up.*

The chalk tray at PEG has been removed. *Students in Adv Level 1/Level 2 through Teams, who use grips will need to supply their own chalk ball. You can purchase one online from a rock-climbing supply store.*

PEG will clean all high-touch surfaces between class hours.

Hygiene stations are set up in the gym and lobby for easy access. *Hand sanitizer is difficult to come by, it is appreciated if you would supply your own, so we can conserve our supply.*

DISTANCING

Visual markings are placed in the lobby and mezzanine.

Each event in the gym has been modified or clearly marked to allow for 6ft distancing.

Shared-use items will be limited as much as possible but is not entirely possible.

Our Instructors will maintain a 6ft distance from your child whenever possible.

Spotting is kept to a minimum and used only when a student is in need of help learning a skill or for their safety

One (1) adult can enter the facility with the student.

Drop-off should be no more than 10mins prior to class and parents need to be onsite promptly at the end of class.

Each student should have a gym bag with them each time they come to their lessons. *It should include the following items; water bottle, hand sanitizer and mask. The bag needs to be large enough so all personal belongings can fit inside.*

FACE MASKS

Face masks are required when entering or exiting the facility. This is due to the small lobby, stairs and mezzanine.

Face masks are optional for our students while in class. *If they do wear one, please make sure it can stay one while jumping and going upside down.*

Spectators need to wear a mask while watching class from the mezzanine.

Instructors will wear a face mask while teaching our recreational classes.
