



OUR MISSION STATEMENT AND PHILOSOPHY

Palouse Empire Gymnastics, PEG GymKids and NinjaZone are dedicated to promoting self-esteem and confidence for each student through the participation and enjoyment of gymnastics and related activities. We are committed to providing an environment which is not only fun, safe and professional, but also captures the essence of childhood!

OUR TEACHING METHODS

Instructors use drills that introduce the skills in smaller, more achievable goals. Strength and flexibility challenges are presented as well as games and safety drills. We strive to teach in a way that our students feel safe to keep trying and failing and eventually succeed. Our GymKids Program is designed to introduce the young child to the skills in gymnastics, but more importantly to develop socially, emotionally and overall coordination. Children will experience a variety of challenges in order to develop basic motor skills, strength and flexibility.

OBSERVATION/ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Spectators are welcome! Please supervise non-participating children carefully. Please refrain from coaching your child from the sidelines. Students are encouraged to arrive on time in order to properly warm-up. Students should be picked up within 15 mins. of class ending. Parents that are more than 20 mins. late will be charged \$1/minute.

ATTIRE/HAIR

The children will be actively moving in and around equipment as well as going upside down. Active attire is necessary for movement and safety. All children will go bare footed or parents may purchase gymnastics shoes. Long hair must be pulled back from the face. PEG and GymKids are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Suggested Attire

Girls: Leotard or biketard. Shorts or leggings. T-shirts okay, but must be tucked in.
Boys: T-Shirt/Ninja Shirt tucked in and shorts or sweat pants.
Toddlers: Any active clothing

Not Allowed

Ballet attire including; tights, shoes, tutus or leotards with skirts
Jeans or Dresses
Fitbit/watches, chokers, rings, necklaces, bracelets, hoop or dangle earrings
Bare mid-drift/Sports bras
Pacifiers, sippy cups or personal toys

CLASS SIZE

Student teacher ratio is 1:6 for preschool children 1:8 for ages 6-10 and 1:10 for ages 10-18. If enrollment drops to 3 or less, the class may be cancelled. **If only one student shows up for class, they will receive a private lesson at 50% time of their normal class.**

CALENDAR

Once a child enrolls in a class, they have that spot through the end of Spring Semester. We do not have sessions. Enrollment is continuous; however, a child may stop lessons at the end of a payment period. Tuition is non-refundable. In special circumstances, an account credit will be applied.

MISSED LESSONS AND MAKE-UP CLASSES

Tuition will not be prorated, credited, refunded or transferred to another student for missed lessons.

Make-up lessons are offered on Saturdays only, by reservation.

Children ages 5 and under are welcome to attend Indoor Playground as a make-up time.

Make-up classes are a benefit that we offer for our students, but are not guaranteed.

Make-up classes are not a replacement for your child's regularly scheduled class.

Make-up classes for school-aged children will be conducted as a general fitness class or a tumbling and trampoline class. This is to accommodate for the varying ages and abilities that sign-up for the class.

Only currently enrolled students may take a make-up class.

For Example: Suzie missed class on October 17th; the ½ semester payment covers classes until October 20th. Suzie's parents have indicated that she will be stopping lessons after the 20th. Her last opportunity as an enrolled student to take a make-up lesson is October 20th. Due to insurance regulations, she cannot take a lesson the following week, because she is no longer an enrolled and paying student.

CANCELLED DAYS/SNOW POLICY

We are open for all Teacher work days and conference days. Monday classes will have their tuition prorated for 1 of the canceled class during Spring Semester. Families will need to schedule a make-up lesson for the other one. Pullman and Moscow Public Schools have very different snow policies. PEG and GymKids will make an independent decision on the weather based on the time of day and travel safety. We will communicate via email, Facebook, phone message and our website if classes are cancelled.

ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE

A non-refundable / non-transferable annual registration fee (\$25+tax) is required for each student entering our program. This fee is valid for one year from the month of purchase and includes a secondary medical insurance (\$500 deductible). Drop-in or session-based classes do not have a registration fee.

DISCOUNTS

Pay full Semester up front - A 10% discount is already applied if paying for the full semester. This discount is only available for the 1st week of the semester. There are no refunds, credits or sibling discounts when paying the full semester tuition.

Sibling Discounts – We offer progressive sibling discounts for families with multiple children. 5%, 10%, 15% etc. Discounts do not apply to full semester payment until the 4th child. Discounts do not apply to the annual registration fee.

LATE PAYMENTS/ RETURNED CHECKS

A \$10 late fee is charged for late payments. Tuition is non-refundable. NSF checks will be charged a \$25 return fee. If the account is not settled within two (2) weeks, the check will be turned over to collections.

DISCONTINUING LESSONS

It is the parent's responsibility to notify the office if their child is stopping lessons. We do not have sessions, so your child retains their spot in class throughout the school year. Please let us know right away if your child will be stopping lessons. We will indicate a drop date in the computer and you will not be charged for the next tuition period. Failure to notify the office will result in a tuition charge and payment may be required if your child is taking a spot and we have a wait list.

MARKETING AND SOCIAL MEDIA

We use printed material, our website, Facebook and Instagram for marketing purposes. Occasionally, we will use photo or video of our classes/students. These images will be used for Palouse Empire Gymnastics' purposes only and will not be given or sold to outside companies. As a general rule we try to get parent verbal permission first and do not identify children by name.
